PROJECT FAILURES

JAN 2012 WHOZAWHAT.COM
JAN 2015 Failed to adequately scope and design initial problem.
Early development was actually done on the production server.
Often fit the problem to fit the code, rather than working a sensible solution.
Test cases were flimsy, if they were even written.
If development were to continue, entire codebase would need an overhaul.

JAN 2016 SIERRA MOUNTAIN BIKE CO.
MAY 2016 Neglected to implement Publish-Subscribe database methods into first engineering release
Allowed technical debt to accrue by permitting overuse of COTS software.
Did not setup a good way for team to keep track of dependencies on the system.

JAN 2016 IMAGE TAMPERING DETECTION
MAY 2016 Failed to correctly implement [Farid's JPEG Ghost detecting algorithm](#) according to specifications.
Neglected to consistently give project adequate weekly time.
Contribution of control supersystem went completely unused.

JUL 2007 AMERIKA LABS

AUG 2011 Took getting “the first 10,000 lines of bad code out” particularly seriously.
Allowed enthusiasm for the project to disrupt my academic life.
Typically did not define and solve one good problem, but hacked away at a few things that looked cool to play with.
Failed to solve everything with shell scripts.
